NOTICE OF REGATTA

AMENDMENT NUMBER 1

1 CAPE 31 CLASS

Amend the Class Flag shown in **Table 2**:

CLASS	FLAG
CAPE 31	Cape 31 flag 

Amend **Table 2** and **12.51** to remove the requirement for Cape 31s to display distinguishing letter "K".

2 SONATA CLASS

Delete the Sonata class from **Table 1** and **Table 3** (all Sonatas will race in IRC).

3 SPORTSBOAT CLASS

Delete **3.3**, and delete the Sportsboat class from **Table 1** and **Table 3** (all Sportsboats will race in IRC).

4 RS ELITE




Delete RS Elite from **Table 1** and **Table 3**

5 PERFORMANCE CRUISERS

Delete references to Performance Cruiser C. There will be two Performance Cruiser classes (A and B).

6 CLUB CRUISERS

Replace the entry for the Club Cruiser class in **Table 2** with the following:

CLASS	FLAG	ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS
CLUB CRUISERS	Blue (C) 	<p>C1. Boats shall have a valid 2022 ISCRS rating issued by the Island Sailing Club (this is free).</p> <p>C2. Cruisers with a hull length between 8m and 12m will be eligible. This class is for genuine cruising boats. Boats considered to be racing boats or performance cruisers should enter under the Performance Cruiser or IRC class. The decision of CWL is final and not subject to appeal. CWL reserves the sole right to accept entries outside the size limits.</p> <p>C3. The class will be split into two divisions, Blue and White.</p> <p>C4. Boats racing in the Club Cruiser classes will not be eligible for the overall Black Group Trophy.</p> <p>C5. Boats shall display distinguishing letter C or F (see NoR 12.5).</p> <p>C6. Boats shall also display the Cruising Association Flag.</p>
